We are using Connect Extension to build a biosecurity community and are seeking funding to add on plant biosecurity resources.

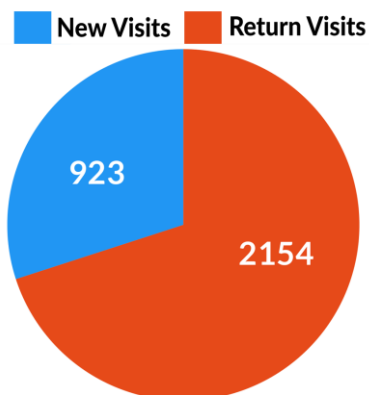

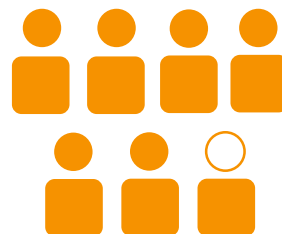
