

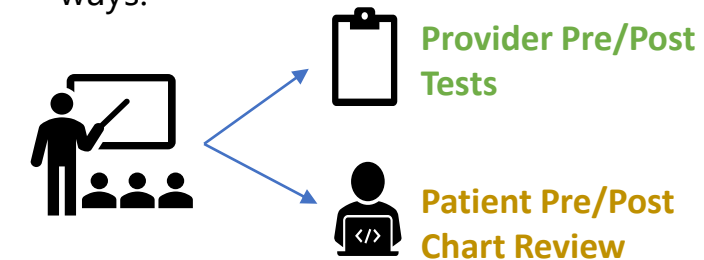


 **10.5%** of the US population lives with diabetes

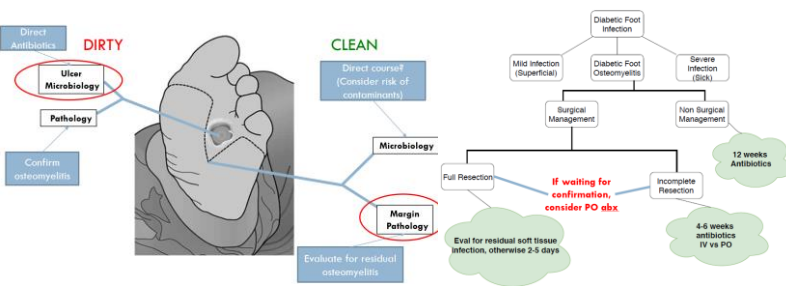
 **34%** of people with diabetes develop foot infection

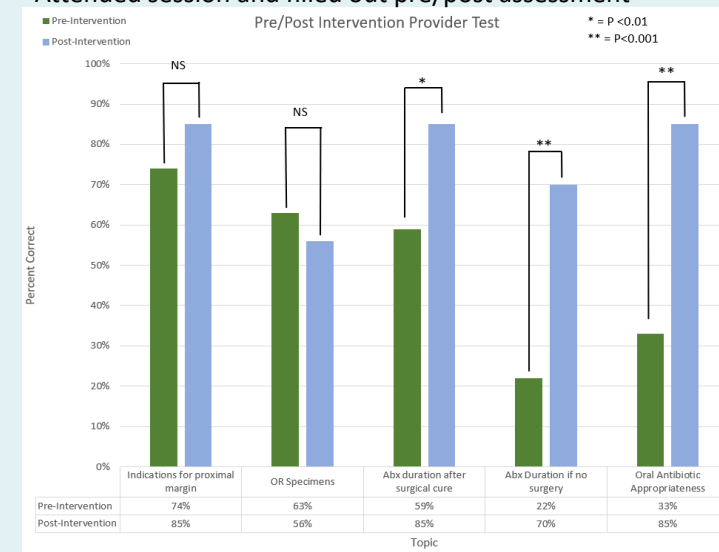
Slides from educational session



A multidisciplinary collaborative educational session improved provider knowledge and patient outcomes in diabetic foot infection

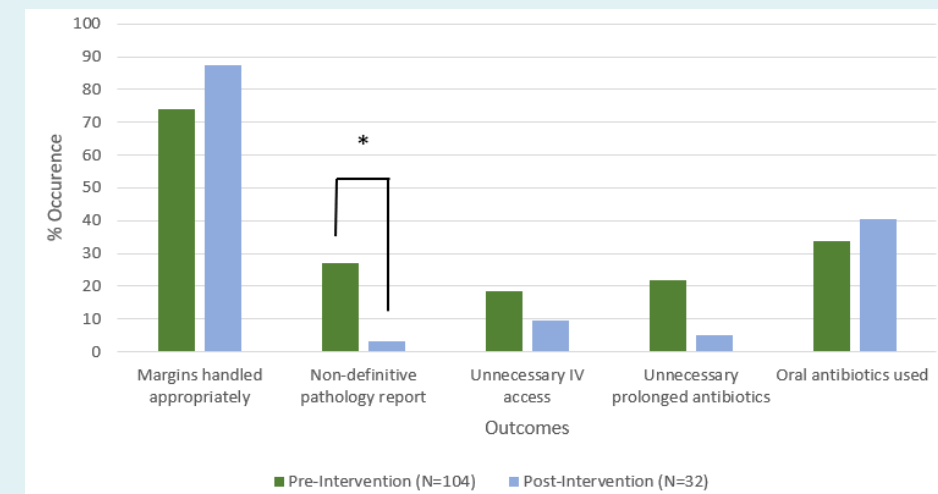
Provider N= 27

Attended session and filled out pre/post assessment



Pre-intervention: N=104

Post-intervention: N=32



Providers who attended the session **significantly improved knowledge in several areas**

Patient **outcomes trended towards improvement**; post-intervention cohort size limited by pandemic
